Applicants must present SAT or ACT scores</p> <p>Saudi Arabia/Middle East: Students who graduate from government/public and bilingual high school programmes that are delivered throughout the Middle East cannot apply for direct entry to RCSI and must take foundation. Must achieve 90% GPA in high school. Saudi Arabian students must also achieve 60% on DIFC maths entry exam.</p>
